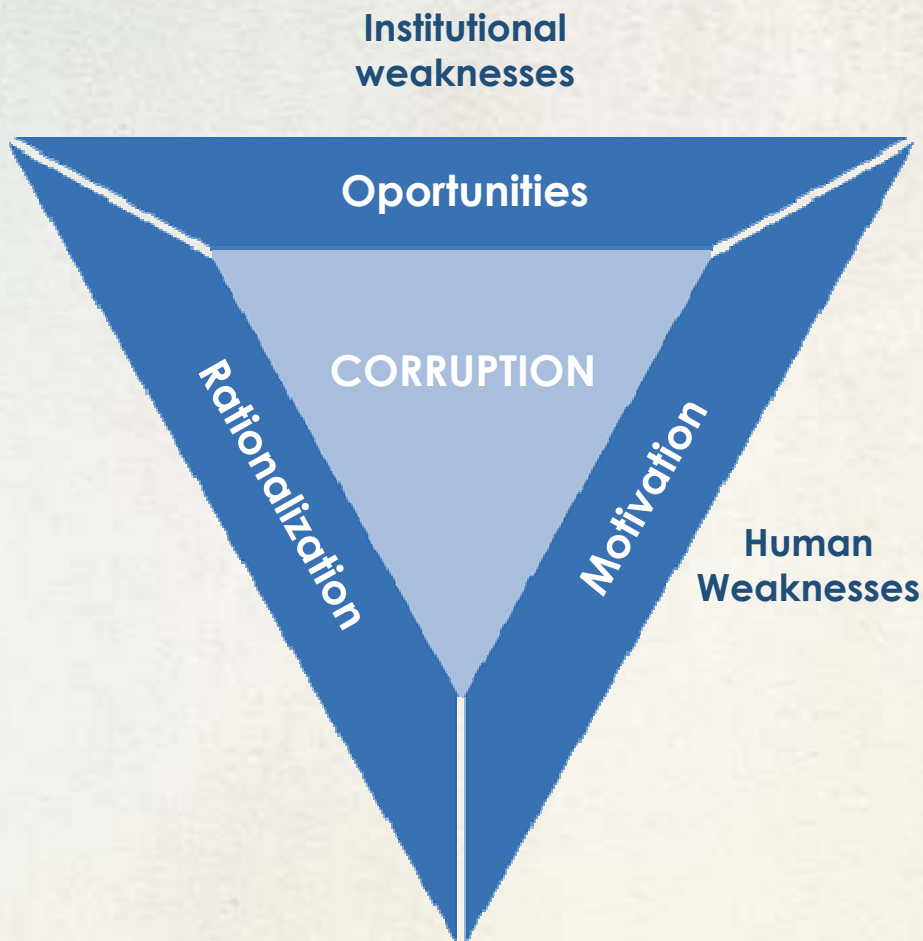

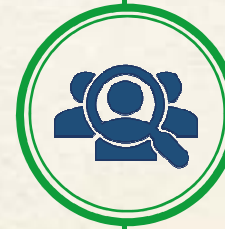




**2,3% GDP** is the estimated cost of corruption in Brazil



**R\$ 200 billion a year** with losses in corruption scheme in Brazil (UN)

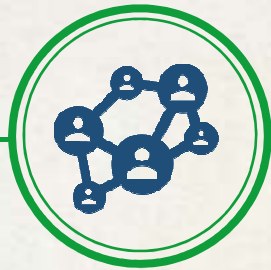


**2 out of 5 executives** pay bribes when rendering services when negotiating with the government (Transparency International)

Improve the Profile of Public Managers (training, experience and background)



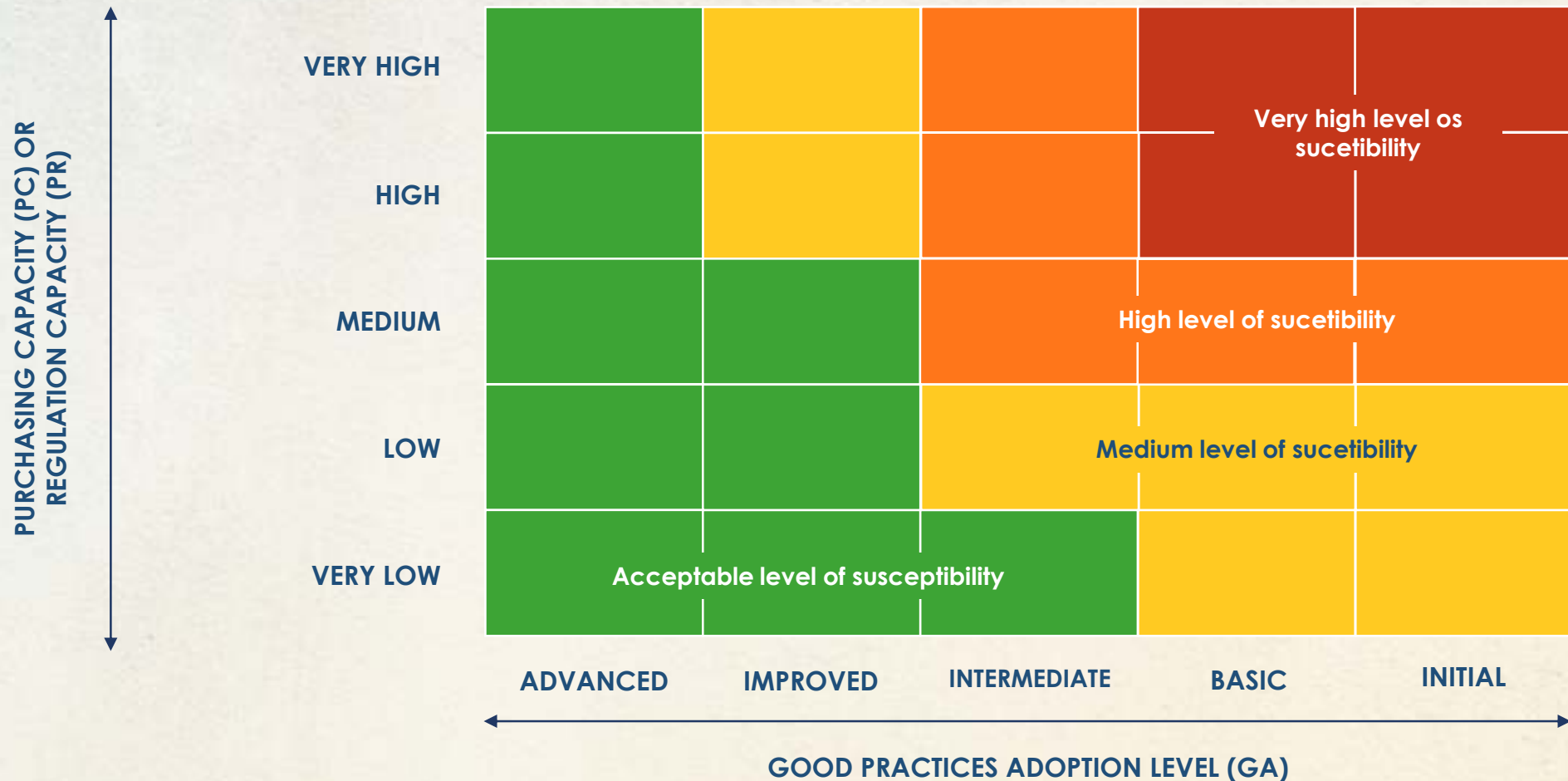
Obtain a real dimension of the cases of fraud and corruption detected, investigated and corrected in Brazil

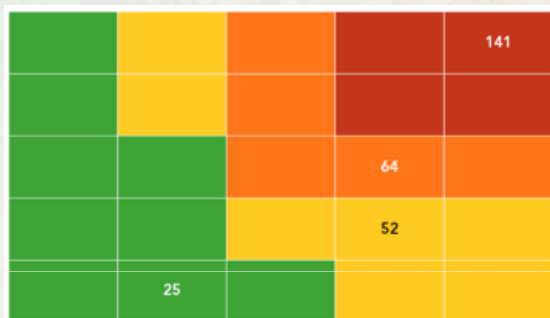

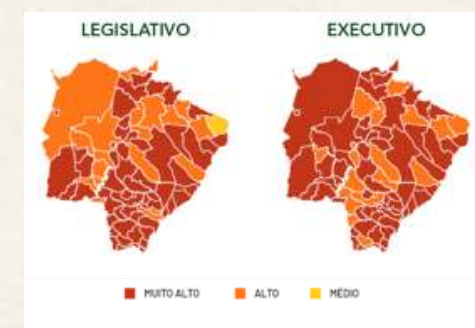
