- ❑ **Strengthening links with citizens, a JF 2025 priority**

WHY A REPORTING PLATFORM?

- A response to public expectations regarding probity and compliance with rules by public managers**
- Support for Chambers' programming to improve the way in which the regularity/probity aspect of organic controls is taken into account.**
- Assistance to detect any shortcomings during an organic inspection.**
- Follow-up of a recommendation of the GUID 5270 "Guideline for the Audit of Corruption Prevention": "Whistleblowing mechanisms are a fundamental means of preventing, detecting and deterring corrupt actions, integrity breaches and inappropriate behavior".**



KEY FIGURES FOR THE REPORTING PLATFORM

1002 alerts reported in 2023 :

- 18% related to misuse of public funds ;
- 14% to particular mismanagement ;
- 11% to conflict of interest ;
- 10% to breaches of the public procurement rules
- 25% others.

12% were considered unusable, 18% unfounded.

42% were forwarded for attribution to the Cour and the Regional and Territorial Chambers of Accounts.

28% are still being processed in 2024.



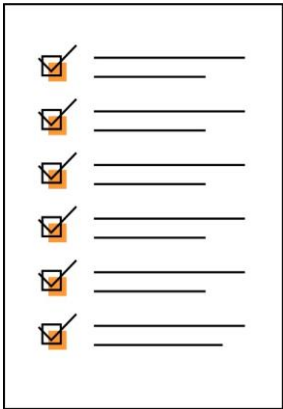
CITIZEN PLATFORM 2023 CAMPAIGN: AN EXTENDED EDITION

- Taking account of feedback: CRTCs involved, change in timetable**
- 20,000 participants, 652 proposals for inspection or survey topics**
- 10 controls selected for the Court, 15 controls selected for the CRTCs**



THE SELECTION PROCESS

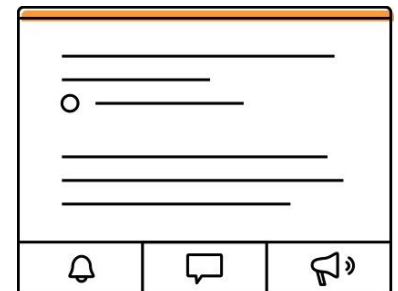
It is based on a number of criteria:



- What's new
- Auditability
- Added value
- Popularity
- Diversity
- Matching to resources

The selection process will be fully documented and a detailed report will be posted online.

In addition, each proposal will be the subject of a personalised response, which will also be made public.





INVOLVE CITIZENS IN OUR CONTROLS

- Participation in public policy evaluations**
- Interview any person who can contribute to a reasonable body of evidences.**
- Access to specialist experts or discussion groups**

- Objective of publishing 100% of the Court of Auditors' reports**
- 30 reports presented to the press and a relevant audience**

- Summaries of the financial jurisdictions' reports**
